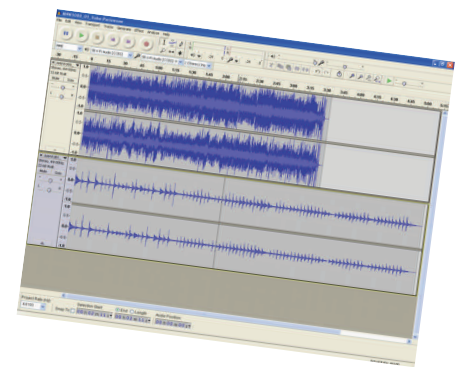

Participants will plan, record, edit and export a podcast during the course. Various editing techniques will be covered using freely available software.

Ideas for the use of Podcasting in the classroom will be explored along with tips, tricks and advice on managing Podcasting projects.

**Audacity**, the editing software used to deliver this course is freely available to download from the internet. It can be used free of charge throughout your school.
